- 4. Children should be given a <u>SAINT'S</u> name.
- Baptism is <u>usually</u> held every fourth Sunday of the month. Parents and Godparents <u>MUST</u> attend <u>ALL</u> meetings before the date of Baptism.
- 6. Godparents **MUST** be sixteen (16) years and older, be **Practicing Catholics** who are able to receive <u>the</u> <u>Sacrament Of The Holy Eucharist</u> on a regular basis, and must have received the <u>Sacrament of Confirmation</u>.
